- 1. Potosi Farmer's Market-** 102 N. Missouri Street, Potosi. Kickoff your day at the Washington County Farmer's Market right behind the County Courthouse in Potosi and across the street at the Town Square. There will be tour information and self-guided maps available at the pavilion 8am-Noonish. Market schedule: Saturdays: 8 am until sell out, mid-June thru October.
- 2. Weeks' Funny Farm/Simply Herbs Apothecary-** Just East of Potosi at 10127 Fairlane Rd., Mineral Point. In keeping with the 'Local Beef' theme, we have Zebu and Highland MINI COWS! 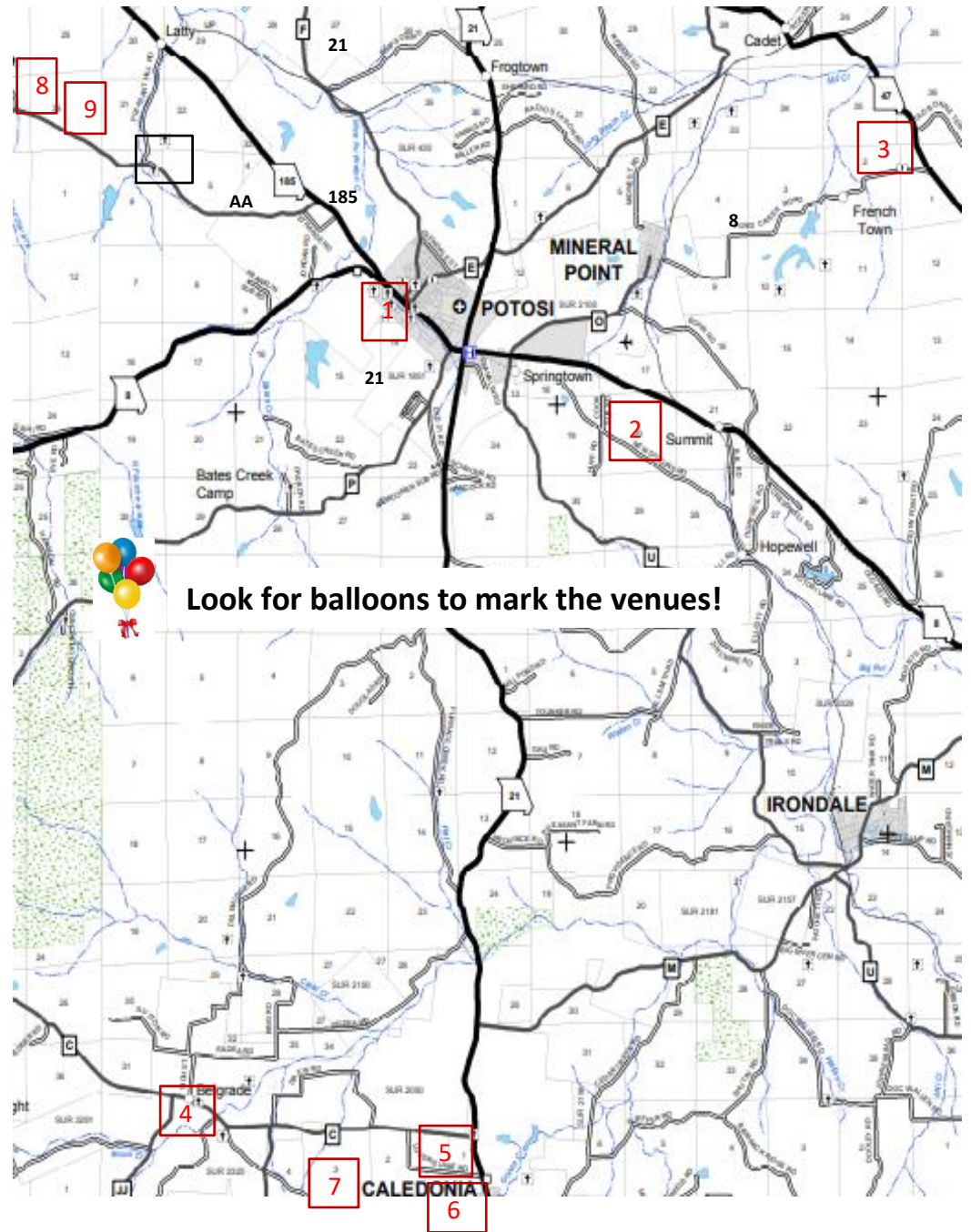
